# REDUCING THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS AT THE COUNCIL

WHEREAS	Bylaw 57 of Quebec government adopted in
	September 2024 states that municipalities of
	2,000 citizens or less could choose to reduce the
	number of councillors sitting at the Council from
	6 to 4;

- **WHEREAS** this decision has to be made prior to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 to be effective for the general election of November 2025 ;
- **WHEREAS** the difficulty of recruiting candidates for election in less populous municipalities ;
- **WHEREAS** a notice of motion to this effect was given at the sitting of council held December 2nd, 2024; and
- **WHEREAS** a public consultation on this effect has been held December 9th, 2024, and a 10 days public notice was given prior;
- **WHEREAS** a draft copy of the present bylaw was given to each council member two days prior to the meeting; and
- **WHEREAS** the members of council declare that they have read the present bylaw and renounce its reading;
