## **TO THE CITIZENS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GROSSE-ÎLE**

Since October 3, 2024, the *Commission municipale du Québec* has acted as the temporary administrator of the Municipality of Grosse-Île, which no longer has enough councillors (quorum) to make decisions.

The *Commission municipale du Québec* will replace the Municipal Council and adopt resolutions in its place so that the municipality can function and municipal services can be provided to citizens.

The two members appointed to temporarily administer the municipality and maintain services to citizens are:

- M<sup>e</sup> Philippe Asselin
- M<sup>e</sup> Martin St-Laurent

During the interim administration, please note that there will be no further Council meetings and no decisions will be taken without the approval of the *Commission municipale du Québec*.

The *Commission* will manage the Municipality until the by-election returns the Municipal Council to the required quorum.

It should be noted that this is not a case of trusteeship of the municipality, but rather an exceptional method of running the municipality while awaiting the election of new council members.
